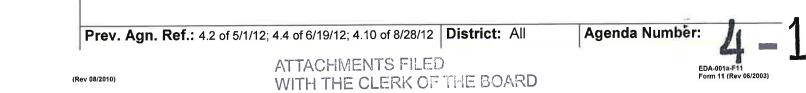

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the the ABx1 26, more specifically subdivision I of Health and Safety Code Section 34177, as amended by AB 1484 (Dissolution Act), successor agencies are required to prepare a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) before each six month fiscal period. Furthermore, subdivision m of Section 34177 requires that "commencing with the ROPS covering the period of July 1, 2013, through December 31, 2013, successor agencies shall submit an oversight board approved ROPS to the Department of Finance and to the county auditor-controller no fewer than 90 days before the date of property tax distribution."

Therefore, the Succesor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (Successor Agency) is required to submit the oversight board approved ROPS covering the period of July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013 (ROPS 13-14A) by March 1, 2013. The Successor Agency is also required to submit an Administrative Budget for each six-month reporting period which corresponds with the ROPS. As shown on Exhibit B, the Administrative Budget for the Successor Agency for the period from July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013 is projected to be \$969,616. This amount represents the three-percent administrative allowance of all RPTTF projections for the six-month period from July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013. Exhibit C details cost categories associated with the projected Administrative Budget for July-December 2013.

Staff recommends adoption of ROPS 13-14A and the Successor Agency Administrative Budget for the period of July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, and authorization for staff to submit these items to the Oversight Board.

18 WHEREAS, an oversight board has been formed, pursuant to Health and Safety Code 19 Section 34179; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 34177(j) requires the Successor Agency to prepare an administrative budget for each sixth month fiscal period and submit it to the Oversight Board for approval; and

23 WHEREAS, the Successor Agency recommends Oversight Board adoption of the 24 Successor Agency's Administrative Budget for the period of July 1, 2013 through December 25 31, 2013.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, AND DETERMINED by the 27 Oversight Board for the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of 28 Riverside as follows:

1. The Oversight Board adopts the Successor Agency's Administrative Budget attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B," for the period of July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.

2. The Board Clerk shall electronically transmit this resolution to the Department of Finance as required pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34179(h).

3. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34177(m), the Department of Finance shall make its determination of the enforceable obligations and the amounts and funding sources of the enforceable obligations no later than 45 days after the Recognized Obligation Payment Scheduled is submitted. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34179(h), all actions taken by the Oversight Board may be reviewed by the State of California Department of Finance, and, therefore, this Resolution shall not be effective until five (5) business days after approval, subject to a request for review by the State of California Department of 13 Finance.
